The Intermountain Section of the Institute of Transportation Engineers annually sponsors a **Student Paper Competition** for transportation engineering students at universities in Idaho, Montana, Nevada, and Utah. We are currently soliciting papers for the 2018 competition.

Please make your students aware of the competition and encourage them to participate. Paper topics can include any aspect of transportation engineering from traffic engineering and highway design to planning or transit issues. A review committee will evaluate the papers submitted based on their content, level of research effort, applicability to the transportation engineering profession, and the author's technical writing skills.

There will be two awards for the Student Paper Competition, with each author of a winning paper receiving a **\$400 cash award**. In addition, the author of the best scoring paper will be encouraged to attend the Intermountain Section meeting in Jackson, Wyoming on May 16-18, 2018 to present their paper as part of the technical program. The Section will provide an additional \$200 to offset the student's travel expenses for attending the meeting. If the top winner cannot attend, then the second winner will be asked to present his or her paper.
